






















The team covering the Antrim and Newtonabbey Area. We have hit the ground running and we have been enjoying every minute of it. Looking forward to the next 4 years!

The Group have had the opportunity to visit Indoor Golf, Go bowling and help out a Queens student with her Masters Reasearch.

























CCOMLIN


We are currently working with a group of up to 20 young males aged 14-17 from the Crumlin area. The population of Crumlin village has grown considerably over the past 10 years, as a result of the influx of residents from Belfast and surrounding areas. The youth provision for this age group in Crumlin is basically non- existant which has had a major impact on the high rates of anti-social behaviour.


The boys in our group would be seen in the community as the 'trouble makers' 'those who are up to no good' however after working with this group over the past three months, it's clear that this is a label applied to these boys. These young people are a great bunch of boys with great capacity. The majority of these boys have complex issues and require the support and opportunities of Peace Bytes.

To date these boys have completed an internet safety project gaining an OCN Level One in Exploring Social Media.

Our work to date with this group has been fun, rewarding and influential. We are looking forward to our work with this group over the next two months.










This quarter seen our Rathcoole day group work through their Peer Mentoring and Good Relations OCN's.

We have made use of the great weather between working hard on qualifications and made the trip to Cityside for Crazy Golf.







The group have enjoyed some trips in keeping with their qualifications and a trip Go-Karting. They also were kind enough to show the Youth Workers about their local area.








